

Walk to Bus Stops Near GHBC (last update May-13-2019)

Bus Routes That Stop Within Half Mile of GHBC:

- o Metrobus 16ACE – Columbia Pike Line – latest timetable Jun-24-2018
 - o A from Pentagon Metro to Patriot & Americana Drs (Annandale)
 - o C from Pentagon Metro to Glen Carlyn & Vista Drs (Cullmore)
- o Metrobus 16GH – Columbia Heights / Pentagon City – latest timetable Jun-24-2018
 - o G from Pentagon City Metro to Carlin Springs & Columbia Pike
 - o H from Pentagon City Metro to Leesburg Pike & Jefferson St
- o Metrobus 25B – Landmark-Ballston Line – latest timetable Jun-21-2015. Two routes:
 - o Ballston Metro to Van Dorn Metro (Mon-Sat)
 - o Ballston Metro to Southern Towers at Seminary Rd & Beauregard St (all days)
Stop at Fillmore St & Beauregard St is opposite Goodwin House Alexandria
- o Metrobus 28A – Leesburg Pike Line – latest timetable Jun-25-2017
 - o from King St Metro in Alexandria to Tyson’s Corner Metro in McLean
- o Arlington 41 – Columbia Pike-Ballston-Courthouse – latest timetable Jun-25-2017
- o Arlington 45 – Columbia Pike-DHS Sequoia-Rosslyn – latest timetable Dec-18-2016

SmarTrip cards issued by WMATA can be used on Metrorail and a great many local bus lines, including Metrobus, Arlington, Alexandria, Fairfax County, Montgomery County and Baltimore. Anyone 65 or older with a valid ID can purchase a Senior SmarTrip card for \$2, which entitles you to a 50% discount on all fares. For seniors, the discounted bus fare is \$1, and within two hours of whatever time you pay that first fare, you can transfer to one or more other buses at no charge. You can add value to your SmarTrip card at any Metro station or on any Metrobus, and then pay fares by touching your card to the fare box.

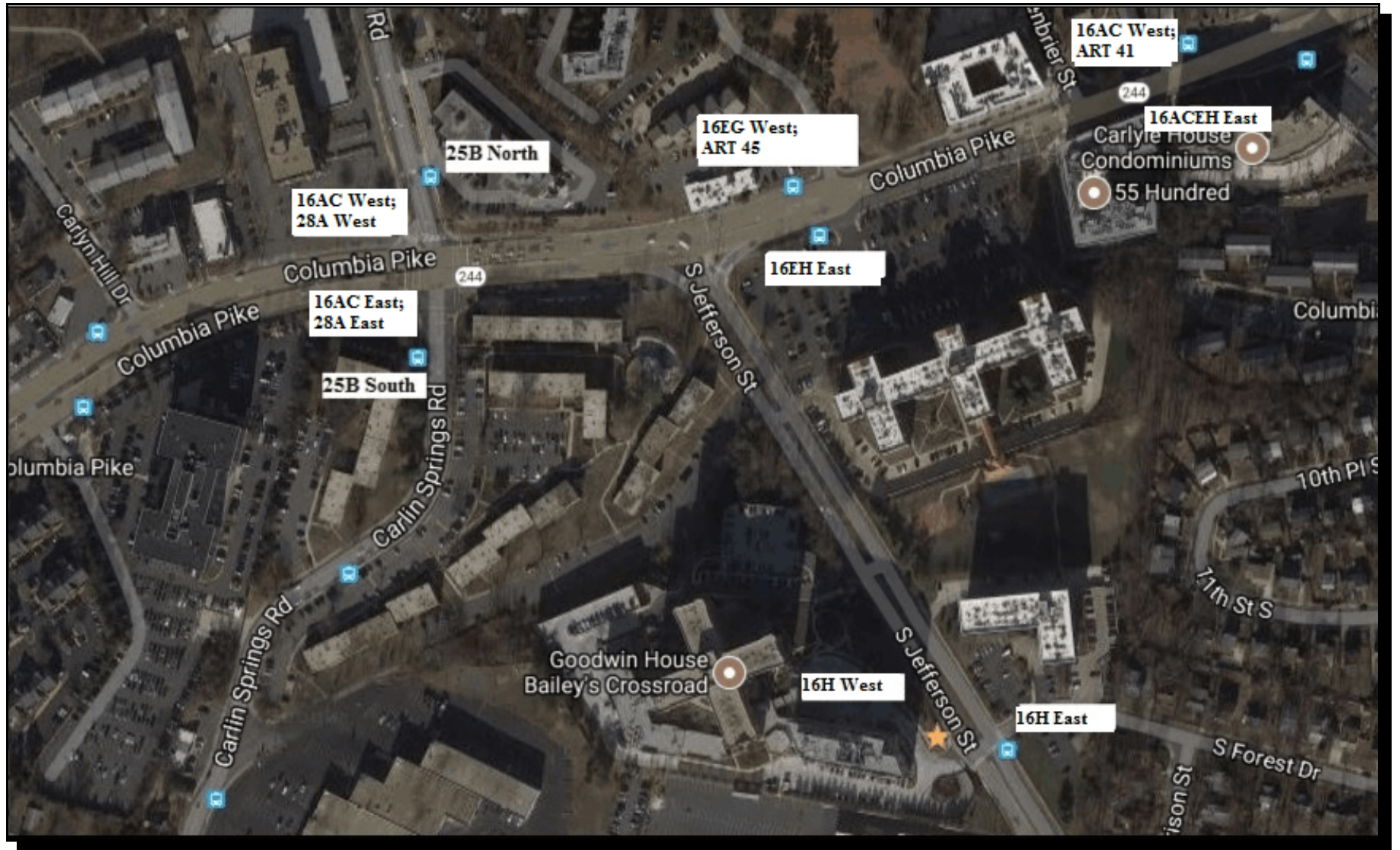

Location of Bus Stops near GHBC:

- o Metrobus 16AC = about 0.3 miles. Left (north) on Jefferson, left (west) on Columbia Pike to Carlin Springs Rd:
 - o South side of Columbia Pike & Carlin Springs = Eastbound to Pentagon (has bus shelter)
 - o North side of Columbia Pike & Carlin Springs = Westbound to Annandale or Cullmore
- o Metrobus 16E = about 0.2 miles – Left (north) on Jefferson, right (east) on Columbia Pike – late night service
 - o South side of Columbia Pike & Jefferson = Eastbound to Pentagon (has bus shelter)
 - o North side of Columbia Pike & Jefferson = Westbound to Annandale or Cullmore
- o Metrobus 16G = about 0.2 miles = Left (north) on Jefferson, cross Columbia Pike and turn right
 - o North side of Columbia Pike & Jefferson = Westbound from Pentagon City to Annandale or Cullmore
- o Metrobus 16H = less than 100 ft. On Jefferson St at GHBC
 - o East side of Jefferson (across street) = Eastbound to Pentagon City
 - o West side of Jefferson (has bus shelter) = Westbound to Skyline
- o Metrobus 25B = about 0.3 miles. Left (north) on Jefferson, Left (west) on Columbia Pike to Carlin Springs Rd:
 - o NE Corner Carlin Springs Rd & Columbia Pk = Northbound to Ballston Metro
 - o SW Corner Carlin Springs Rd & Columbia Pk = Southbound to Van Dorn Metro
- o Metrobus 28A = about 0.3 miles. Left (north) on Jefferson, Left (west) on Columbia Pike to Carling Springs Rd:
 - o SW Corner Columbia Pike & Carlin Springs = Eastbound to King St (has bus shelter)
 - o NW Corner Columbia Pike & Carlin Springs = Westbound to Tysons (seats but no shelter)
- o Arlington 41 = about 0.4 miles. Left (north) on Jefferson, right (east) on Columbia Pike to Greenbrier St:
 - o North side of Columbia Pike = Both Eastbound and Westbound trips stop here. Like Metrobus 16GHK, Eastbound circles north on Carlin Springs and then back south on Dinwiddie before heading east on Columbia Pike to Ballston, Clarendon & Courthouse.
- o Arlington 45 = about 0.2 miles, same as for Metrobus 16GHK.
 - o North side of Columbia Pike = Both Eastbound and Westbound trips stop here. Like Metrobus 16GHK, Eastbound circles north on Carlin Springs and then back south on Dinwiddie before heading east on Columbia Pike to Rosslyn

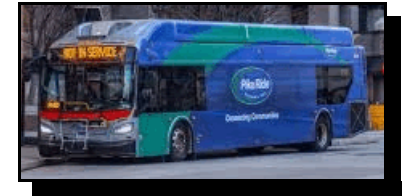
Historical Note: Effective June 24, 2018, WMATA *significantly* revised most of the Metrobus 16 routes. For those familiar with the prior route structure, the correspondence of the new routes to the old is something like this:

- o Metrobus 16C replaces Metrobus 16B – stops on Columbia Pike and connects with Metro at same station (Pentagon)
- o Metrobus 16H replaces Metrobus 16J and Metrobus 16P -- stops on Jefferson St directly in front of GHBC, but connects with Metro at a different station (Pentagon City, instead of Pentagon).



Although exact design details may vary, these images will give you a general idea of what the buses and bus stops look like. Each bus stop sign shows the id numbers of all the bus routes that stop there. Although Fairfax Connector and Alexandria buses don't stop near GHBC, you can transfer to them from buses that do stop here.
