Dear GHBC Residents,

The Infection Precaution and Planning (IPP) team meets regularly to monitor the latest policies, guidance and case rates in our region and on our campuses. At their meeting earlier this week, the IPP team discussed upcoming vaccine clinic dates for those who qualify for a second dose of the bivalent COVID-19 vaccine. Additionally, the team decided to move forward with our third phase of gradual reduction in mask requirements.

Phase 3 goes into effect on Friday, May 19 with the following updates:

- Residents, team members, visitors and vendors are no longer required to wear masks in the Health Care Center.
- Team members and vendors are no longer required to wear a mask if they are in residents' apartments when residents are present.

As before, any individual who prefers to wear a mask may do so in all areas and at any time. We ask you to be mindful of residents and team members who might prefer to wear a mask, and whether or not they are comfortable around others who are not wearing masks. Reasonable accommodations can and should be made for these individuals.

COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Clinics

The CDC recently approved a second dose of the updated bivalent vaccine from Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna for those who are 65+ or who are moderately or severely immunocompromised.

We are partnering once again with Van Dorn Pharmacy to offer the booster dose to any residents or qualifying team members who wish to receive it.

Vaccine clinics will be held in the Auditorium on June 15. Email ghbcvax@goodwinliving.org to schedule your appointment to receive the booster dose.
