GROUNDS COMMITTEE CHARTER

The Grounds Committee of the Resident Council will represent the Council and the residents in all matters relating to the current and future care, maintenance, appearance, development, and improvement of the grounds at Goodwin House Bailey's Crossroads.

The duties of this committee shall include:

Arranging for the upkeep of the Knoll Garden among the residents. This will include removal of weeds, large fallen leaves that take years to decompose, and diseased plants; pruning of overgrown shrubs or ground cover that is encroaching on the sidewalk; mulching with leaf mulch both for plant nutrition and for a tidy appearance to the garden; adding of plants as needed. If major pruning or deep digging is necessary, the Grounds Supervisor must be contacted ahead of time.

Coordinating with Resident Services on the Spring Garden Party.

Coordinating with the Grounds Supervisor on the Garden Box competition.

Bringing concerns or suggestions from residents to the attention of the Grounds Supervisor.

Making recommendations as is appropriate to the Resident Council and to Administration regarding matters within its purview.

The Chairman of the Resident Council is an ex officio member of the Grounds Committee.
