Dear Goodwin House Bailey's Crossroads Residents –

We are writing you today to provide an update on two topics. The first topic is implementation of our protocols regarding the residential living resident and the staff member who tested positive for COVID-19 this week. The second topic is Goodwin House's plans to implement a widespread testing program.

As part of the protocols that we have shared with you, we are undertaking contact tracing for the resident and staff member who tested positive. The contact tracing extends to 48 hours prior to the COVID-19 test being administered to the resident and staff member. Any residents and staff who may have been exposed have been contacted personally by a member of the management team and will be tested for COVID-19. We will be assisted with the testing by Fairfax County Health Department staff.

We have closed the Clinic through the weekend to undertake a deep cleaning of the area. Should you need medical assistance, the nursing supervisor is available and can be reached at extension 7256. You can also dial "0" for the Reception Desk and the receptionist will contact the Nursing Supervisor.

With respect to expanding our testing program, we continue to make progress in securing additional testing kits and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and expanding our relationship with testing laboratories. These efforts will allow us to implement baseline testing in the near future for all residents and staff, beginning with our Health Care and Assisted Living residents and staff, and continuing through the rest of our community.

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We are committed to keeping residents and staff healthy. Please join us in our efforts to keep our community infection-free.



As a reminder, if you are not feeling well or you are experiencing unusual symptoms, please do not come to the Clinic. Instead, call the Nursing Supervisor at extension 7256 or dial "0" for the Reception Desk, so we can attend to your situation safely.
