

## **PLACES OF INTEREST FOUND ON THE GROUND FLOOR**

**30. Auditorium:** Location for all large gatherings such as movies, speakers, Town Hall, Community meetings, Saturday night movies and other entertainment.

**31. Personal Laundry/Dry Cleaning:** Available for personal clothing and linens at a fee. Open M-F, 9am-12n, 1245pm to 3pm and 315pm to 4pm

**32. Beauty Salon:** Erin Fenstomocher, Manager, Hair care for men and women, nail salon services, and massages.

**33. Arlington Federal Credit Union:** All normal bank services. Open Tuesday 1:30 to 4:30pm, Thursday 9am-12n, Friday 1:30pm-4:30pm

**34. Computer Center:** No reservation needed. Four computers available for resident use. One additional computer found in library and one at Resident Business Center on first floor.

**35. Information Technology Office:** Provides internal support to GHBC staff. Residents needing help may either call the Internet Help Desk or sign up for individual computer help in the notebook located in the Resident Business Office.

**36. Facilities Management Office:** Jim Colston, Director of Facilities Management & Environmental Services. Responsibility for maintenance, engineering, grounds, reception desk and security.

**38. Clinical Pastoral Education Office:** Office and training area for CPE staff and trainees

**39. Environmental Services Office:** James Colston, Director. Estephanie Rubio answers all calls to Facilities Management and Environmental Services. It is the clearing center for assistance with services for apartments such as leaks, lights bulb changes, hanging pictures and mirrors, issues with TVs or help taking items to and from your storage bin.

**40. Entrance to Pointe Garage:** This passageway runs to the end of the corridor opposite the auditorium. It is useful as a passage to the Pointe elevators but only if you are carrying a pass key to open the door to the

elevator well in the Pointe. Some Crossroads residents park in Pointe garage (with permission from Management and Security).

**41. Media Room:** Many education programs and films shown here. See *West Winds*.

**42: Woodworking Shop:** The Woodworking shop is open for resident use during hours posted by volunteers who will help with furniture repair. Posted hours: Tues 10-2, Wed 10-2.

**43. Resident Storage:** Storage area for Crossroads Residents. Each apartment has a numbered pen in the storage area. Resident Storage is usually locked; access is by resident access card.

**43a. Entry to Loading Dock:**

**44: WhatNot Shop:** The shop is manned by volunteers and accepts donations of anything except clothing and books. A good place to get rid of anything you do not need or to pick up real bargains. Collected money goes to the GH Foundation. Donate 10am to 12n on alternate Thursdays.

**45. WhatNot Storage/Workroom:**

**45a: Medical Records: Health Information. Central repository for resident medical records.**

**46. 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Elevator:** Just short of the door to the Crossroads Garage is an elevator which leads to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors of the Crossroads. Can be useful when a crowd exits the auditorium and rushes to the main elevators.
